



## 24-25 WAHOSA Competitive Event Blocks

Washington HOSA student delegates are allowed to compete in up to three competitive events at the State Leadership Conference (SLC). Delegates may participate in as many recognition events as they would like, in addition to their competitive events. [Review all event guidelines here.](#)

To facilitate efficient scheduling of events, “competitive blocks” will be instituted moving forward. Students will not be able to compete in events in the same competitive block, with exception to Block 1 as it consists of events with on-line tests completed during the on-line testing window prior to SLC. The blocks and their assigned competitive events are outlined below. Delegates and Advisors are encouraged to use this document to avoid registering for events in conflicting blocks. This would be especially important for events in which teammates are involved to accommodate differing event schedules

### Overview of Blocks

At Chapter’s School/Facility/Building

Block 1 – February 3rd-14th; specific test dates and times arranged by Advisor(s)

At SLC – Spokane Convention Center

ATC Block – Tuesday, March 11th; prior to the Opening Session, students must be registered for ATC tests prior to the SLC deadline, students cannot register for ATC tests on site.

- **ATC tests do not count towards a student’s 3 competitive events.** Students can register for 2 ATC tests with registration. If they want to take 3 or more tests, a charge of \$10 per test will be added to the student’s registration.

Block 3 – Wednesday, March 12th from 8am to 12pm

Block 4 – Wednesday, March 12th from 2pm to 6pm

### Example Scenarios

A delegate could compete in three of the on-line test only competitive events in Block 1. This, however, would prevent them from competing in any events physically at SLC as they will have already reached their three competitive event max.

A delegate could compete in Behavioral Health (an on-line test only event in Block 1), Sports Medicine (an on-line test plus Round 2 element event in Block 1 and 4, respectively) and EMT (an on-line test plus Round 2 element event in Block 1 and 3, respectively), assuming the on-line tests are scheduled by the Advisor in such a manner there isn’t a conflict. Should this delegate qualify for Round 2 in both Sports Medicine and EMT, they would not have a conflict as Sports Medicine – Round 2 is in Block 4 and EMT – Round 2 is in Block 3. As the EMT event requires two competitors, a conflict could arise if a partner is registered to compete in a different event in Block 3.

### Competition Upload Requirements

Students will be required to upload competitive digital materials to the HOSA CMS System. If students qualify for ILC, they will need to resubmit their documents utilizing the CMS system. This change is expected to be user friendly.

### Competitions with a required upload

1. Clinical Specialty (Portfolio)
2. Community Awareness (Portfolio by one team member)
3. Emotional Well-Being Challenge (Cover page, Summary of the Evaluation Plan/Tool, and URL Link for Digital Recorded Presentation) - **WAHOSA SLC will not have an in-person presentation component**
4. Exploring Medical Innovation (exhibit plan by one team member)
5. Family Medicine Physician (Interview Verification Form)
6. Health Career Display (display plan by one team member)
7. Health Career Photography (Portfolio)
8. Health Education (Portfolio by one team member)
9. **HOSA Happenings (Portfolio by one chapter student) - WASHINGTON ONLY**
10. Interviewing Skills (Personal Statement and Resume)
11. Job Seeking Skills (Personal Statement and Resume)
12. Medical Innovation (exhibit plan by one team member)
13. Mental Health Promotion (Reference pages, Completed Mental Health Consultation Form, and Digital File/Link to the Social Media Campaign by one team member)
14. MRC Partnership (Portfolio by one team member)
15. Public Health ('Trailer' video by one team member, Convince the Judges!)
16. Public Service Announcement (PSA Link, Airdate Form, Copyright Form, and Reference Pages by one team member)
17. Researched Persuasive Writing and Speaking (Paper)
18. Research Poster (Poster)
19. **Respiratory Therapy (Recorded Round 1 Presentation) - WASHINGTON ONLY**

### Pre-Judging

For competitions with a digital upload, Washington HOSA may choose to use scores from pre-judging as a qualifier for in-person competition.

### Considerations for Required Submissions:

There is a file size limit for submissions. To avoid an upload error, please be sure to save your PDF as a compressed file or reduce the size of your embedded images. For instructions on how to do this, please visit: <http://www.hosa.org/reducing-file-size/>

If your competition has a required link, please ensure that the video is available to view publicly online. To ensure that your link can be viewed, you can open a private or incognito browser window and enter the link. If your video can be viewed in a private or incognito window, it is publicly available. If not, you will need to figure out how to make your video public. A recommendation is to do this on YouTube through an unlisted or public video.

For the 2024 – 2025 membership year, the HOSA Digital Upload System will be used.
