

Online Testing

Online testing will take place from February 5-16, 2024, at each individual school. Proctors will receive an email from HOSA with instructions for accessing the tests. Once logged in, proctors will have login information, by event, for each student testing.

Troubleshooting/FAQ for Online Testing

What if a proctor has not received their login information?

If your proctor has not received their login information by February 7th and you have confirmed they are a registered proctor (instructions here: <https://youtu.be/abZIwAcMWag>), please contact Washington HOSA at (425) 365-3492. If there is no response, please email office@wahosa.org and call HOSA at (800) 321-4672 to ask for the login information.

What if a test will not start?

If a student's test won't start, have them sign out of the test and sign back in at testing.hosa.org. If that doesn't work, have them restart their computer and clear the cache and cookies (instructions here: <https://its.uiowa.edu/support/article/719>)

If the test still won't start and the proctor is sure they have hit the "start test" button on their portal, please call Washington HOSA at (425) 365-3492. If there is no response, please email office@wahosa.org and call HOSA at (800) 321-4672 outlining the issue.

What if a test is exited before the student has finished?

If the test was exited before the student was done (e.g. if your school's power goes out in the middle of the test) please contact Washington HOSA at (425) 365-3492 and email office@wahosa.org outlining the situation and why the test was exited before the student was done. There is a possibility that the test may be reset at the discretion of the Executive Director.

What if a test was submitted before the student was done (e.g. a student hit "Submit" instead of "Next")?

If the student accidentally submits the test before they are completed, please contact Washington HOSA at (425) 365-3492 and email office@wahosa.org. The test may be reset at the discretion of the Executive Director based on the situation.
